Early Years Outcomes

73% of children in our Reception Class (30 children) reached a good level of development (the expected level for children leaving Early Years).

Year 1 Phonics Check

All children take a national assessment in Year 1 to assess their phonic ability. **93%** (30 children) passed the check.
