**Wave 1 –  
Quality First Teaching**

The majority of children achieve well through high quality classroom teaching. However if they are falling behind their peers or their targets they may need extra support via differentiation of school and home work or TLA supported group work in class in order not to fall into the category of Wave 2 or 3 in future.

No child at Wave 1 needs an IEP.

**Wave 2 –  
Small group and one to  
one interventions**

Some children require additional support to achieve well. This can often be provided through small group, time limited intervention programmes delivered by a member of the school's classroom based support team that will advance children's progress and help them achieve in line with their peers.

Parents need to be informed of interventions. Some children at Wave 2 will need an IEP and an intervention review meeting every 10-12 weeks with the child and their parents.

**Wave 3 –  
Intensive support**

This is for those children who require the personalised approach of a programme that is tailored to their specific, often severe, difficulties. It is usually taught as a one to one programme by a specialist teacher or a member of the support staff who has undertaken some additional training for teaching children with special educational needs.

Parents need to be informed that their child is on the schools SEN register. All children at Wave 3 will need an IEP and an intervention review meeting every 10-12 weeks with the child and their parents

**Wave 4-  
Education and Health  
Care Plans.**

This is for those children who have been statutorily assessed by the authority as having special educational needs and requiring a GRIP or EHC plan. They will be assisted in achieving their targets by specialised outside agencies who will work with and alongside Chinley Primary School staff.

Parents need to be invited to regular planning and review meetings All children at Wave 4 will have a plan and an intervention review meeting at least every 10-12 weeks with the child, their parents and other agencies.
